The United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) are a globally agreed sustainability framework. But are you aligning your investments with the goals?

Investors would like to measure how well sovereign bonds meet the SDGs, but it's not necessarily easy for them to do this, as the data is scattered across different sources.

Powered by the market-leading macroeconomic time series database Datastream®, Refinitiv – Country SDG Scores are designed to transparently and objectively measure a country's relative performance across each of the Sustainable Development Goals and sub-metrics.

The scores are calculated based on mapping SDG indicators to available information in the Datastream macroeconomic database.

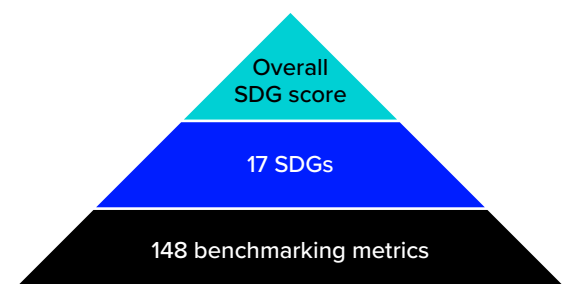
Data and coverage

The country scores cover:

- 210 countries
- 17 UN SDGs
- 148 metrics that compose the SDGs

Score structure

Scores are calculated using the latest available information, providing an overall, SDG level and individual metric level performance scores.

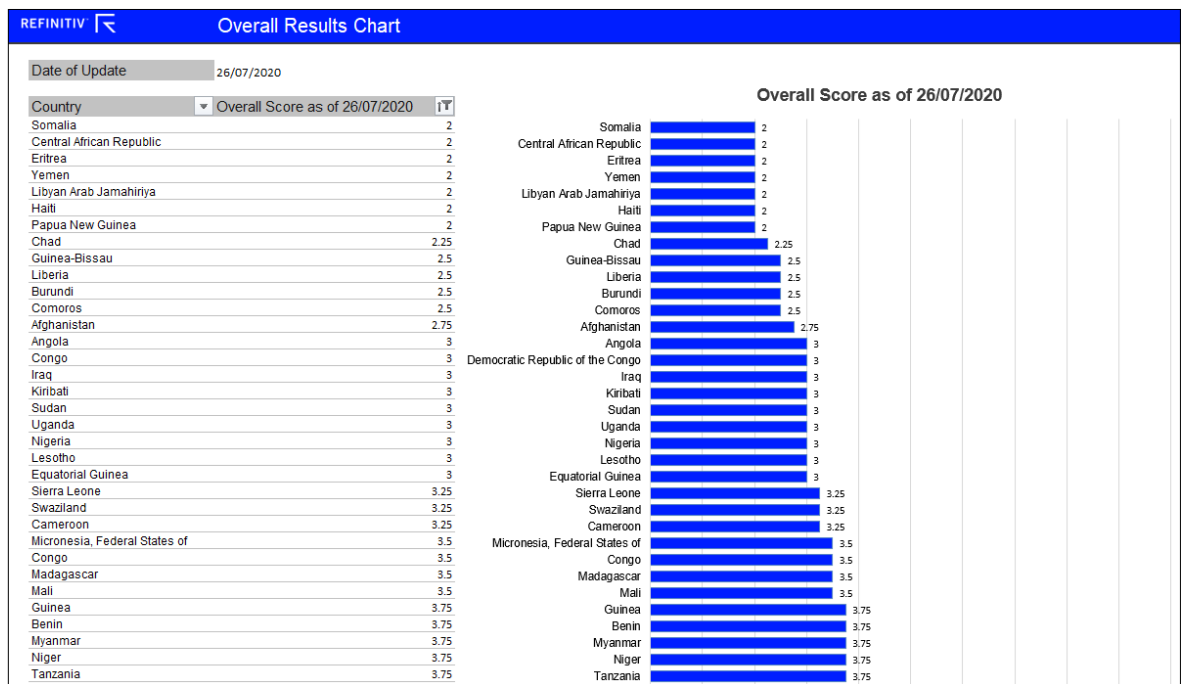
